

Greenwood Cemetery Rules

Established: September 1, 2002

Adopted: March 11, 2003

Effective: March 11, 2003

Rules Applicable to the Greenwood Cemetery Located in the City of Warren

Rules:

- Concrete boxes or equivalent must be used as a container for caskets.
- Footstones must be set flush with the ground.
- Head stones must be set on an adequate footing that is flush with the ground, with at least 6" extending on all sides.
- Monument placement must be coordinated with the cemetery sexton.
- Shrubs and trees planted by the family must be maintained by the family and cannot be planted in such a manner so as to interfere with mowing of the cemetery.
- Flowers that are planted in the spring should be planted in a manner so as not to interfere with mowing. Fresh cut flowers will be removed when dried up.
- Artificial flower arrangements that are placed by Memorial Day should be removed by June 14. If it is the desire of the family to leave the artificial flowers all summer, the flowers must be placed in such a manner as not to interfere with the mowing of the cemetery.
- Flowers blowing around the cemetery or interfering with mowing will be disposed of.
- Perpetual Care is defined as any maintenance required in the cemetery to keep it looking good, including the maintaining of markers at the proper level.
